

VATT OBSERVER PROCEDURES

Due to limited resources associated with the VATT operation, failure to comply with these procedures may result in a delay or loss of observing time.

- Permit requests: Permits must be requested at least 1 week prior to visit. Please be sure to provide the names and dates of each individual.
- Room reservations: Please contact Barbara Abril at least 1 week prior to visit. Please be sure to provide the names and dates of each individual.
- Vehicle permits: If you will not be driving a state or federally licensed vehicle, please provide the following information: Year, Make, Model, Color, State, License # and whom the vehicle is registered to.
- Supplies provided: Facility keys, radio, instruction sheets (milepost log, radio instructions and frequencies etc.)
- Arrival time: Base camp hours are from 6:00 am to 4:30 pm Monday thru Friday. It is very important that you advise us of your arrival time. If you will be arriving after hours/weekends, you will need to use the personnel gate and retrieve your information from the lockbox (located on the front corner of building). Please be sure to obtain the combination for the gate and lockbox from Barbara Abril in advance.
- All VATT permits will be placed in the lock box as soon as we receive them from the Forest Service, whether the user arrives during the week or weekend. Upon your arrival please access the lockbox to retrieve your paperwork and proceed to office for check in. Should you encounter any problems at your time of arrival, please contact MGIO Duty person at 928-965-3100.
